EVALUATION CRITERIA

Nkandla Local Municipality subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000) read with The Revised Preferential Procurement Regulations – Gazette No. 27636, 30 May 2005. The 80/20 preference point system shall be applicable during the evaluation and adjudication of proposals.

- **First stage** - returnable & completeness then functionality 100% (minimum threshold of 70%) being 80 % for experience and 20% for capacity
- **Second stage** – Preferential Points System (80/20); 80 for Price and 20 for B-BBEE contribution status level allocated. Only bidders who pass the first stage with a minimum of 70% will then be evaluated further in the second stage.
